WEEK 1 | MAR 3

God Story: Jesus and the Children

Luke 18:15-17

Our Story: Jesus showed us that little children are important in his kingdom. They have a role to play. This week, show your child that they have an important role in your family by giving them a new responsibility. Toddlers can help in a variety of ways and making something their "job" in the family will give them a sense of responsibility and value.

WEEK 2 | MAR 10

God Story: Jesus Teaches His Disciples to Serve Matthew 20:20-28

Our Story: This week, encourage your child to identify one person (or more!) that they can serve in love this week eg. Bake cookies together and take them to a neighbour or help a sibling with a chore.

WEEK 3 | MAR 17

God Story: Jesus Heals a Man

Luke 18:35-43

Our Story: In this week's story, Jesus took time to stop what He was doing and where He was going to serve a blind man, Bartimaeus. Sometimes in our busyness, we don't stop to serve those who need it. As you go through your week with your little one, try to model this for them. See the people around you and take time to care and serve them.

God Story: Palm Sunday

Luke 19:28-40

Our Story: This week, emphasize and focus on ways you can praise God as a family. Take a special car ride just to listen and sing along to praise music together, create a praise wall with post it notes of things you want to praise God for, or come up with your own ways to praise!

WEEK 5 | MAR 31 EASTER SUNDAY

God Story: Easter

Mark 15-16, Luke 22-24, Matthew 26-28

Our Story: This month, don't let Easter pass too quickly. Sit in the awareness that Jesus is Lord and Tle has defeated death. As you sit in that, your child will see the results.

Ask your child: What is Easter really about? (Help your child focus in on Jesus!)
